Our Mission: To promote economic growth while enhancing the quality of life in Northwest Connecticut.

COVID RELIEF

- Provide funding for collaborations to ensure proper notifications regarding COVID relief resources.
- Engage the business community in planning, managing and distributing state and federal relief funds to stabilize and strengthen businesses.
- Help Social Service organizations recover from the profound impact of the burdens COVID has placed on them.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT & EDUCATION

- Invest in partnerships that can provide alternative and creative ways to utilize transportation to accommodate employers and employees.
- Develop educational opportunities in the vocational trades to provide more options for students to made sound career choices suited to their skill sets, culture and interests.
- Support regional institutions of higher learning, such as Northwestern Connecticut Community College, to prepare students for high tech careers including cyber-security.
